Tuition Assistance

John W. Hallahan Catholic Girls' High School Alumnae Academic Scholarship

Each fall a scholarship test is administered to any eighth grade student who has registered for Hallahan. Academic scholarships are awarded to the students with the highest scores. The Hallahan Alumnae Association provides funds for these academic scholarships.

The Mary McMichan Grant

The Mary McMichan Grant is a legacy grant in the amount of \$500.00 and will be awarded to incoming ninth grade students. These students must be a daughter, granddaughter, or sister of a Hallahan Graduate. The Mary McMichan Endowment funds this one-time grant, and it is for incoming freshmen only.

Charles E. Ellis Grant

The Charles E. Ellis Foundation provides grants to girls who have financial need and meet the criteria set by the Ellis Foundation. Eligibility is limited to qualified female students in good academic standing, who reside in Philadelphia, live in a one-parent household and request assistance. Grants are generally not available to incoming freshmen. Application forms are available through the Finance Office. All applications must be sent by the applicant to the Ellis Foundation directly.

Tuition Assistance Program (TAP)

The Office of Catholic Education also funds a Tuition Assistance Program (TAP). Applications are available in February in the Hallahan Tuition Office and online. The application fee is \$15.00, and the deadline for this application is generally mid-April. Applications must be sent to the address provided on the application, and not to Hallahan.

Hallahan Financial Aid

Each year the Institutional Advancement Office raises funds for tuition assistance. These funds are distributed on an as-needed basis. An application and documentation must be submitted on or before April 15. Financial Aid forms are available in the tuition office. The amount of financial aid available depends on donations received.

Business Leaders Organized for Catholic Schools (BLOCS)

Business Leadership Organized for Catholic Schools (BLOCS) raises scholarship funds for income-qualified students attending elementary and secondary schools in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. Each year, as a result of the generosity of our donors, thousands of children receive scholarship support to attend these excellent schools. BLOCS work within the State of Pennsylvania EITC guidelines and uses an outside scholarship administrator to determine eligibility for scholarship grants.
